Prizes for Champions may, at the option of the exhibitor, be in the form of product (subject to availability), based on the value of the prize as set out above. Prizes for individual classes may also, at the option of the exhibitor, be in the form of product (subject to availability), based on \$5 for first, \$3 for second.

Prizes will be allocated starting Saturday noon so that they are available for pickup later that afternoon. If you believe that any result is incorrect, Barry or Marilyn Larkin must be informed before 12 noon on Saturday, failing which, the result cannot be corrected.

Terms of Entry for the Melbourne Orchid Spectacular 2018

Please read carefully.

1. Set up times are strictly: Wed. 9:00am – 4:30pm
2. Invited orchid societies and invited commercial traders are eligible to enter. Each such society or commercial trader is entitled to set up only one display which may, but need not, be a theme display. No stand backdrop may be taller than 1.8m unless the Show Marshal allows otherwise. Backdrops must be free standing. Individuals may exhibit on more than one display. Individuals may exhibit in conjunction with a commercial trader's display.

3. All exhibits must have been owned and grown by the exhibitor for at least six months.
4. Each person entering a plant **must** register his or her name to receive an exhibitor **NUMBER** and exhibitor **PASS**. Early registration may be arranged by calling Meryl Early on **03 9786 1938**. All plants exhibited for judging must be clearly labeled with the correct name of the plant, accurately spelled and the exhibitor number on the **bottom left hand corner** of the label. Labels must enable Judges to distinguish between similar plants exhibited by an exhibitor. All labels must be clearly visible for judging.
5. For each **Notifiable** class, a 'Notifiable Sheet' must be provided by the exhibitor to the Registration Desk. The appropriate **coloured spot/s**, available at the Registration Desk, must be placed on the **lower right hand corner of the label**.

**You must return Notifiable Sheets to the Registration Desk by
no later than 4.30 pm WEDNESDAY**

6. **Mistakes in labeling of plants may result in the plant not being judged.** If you have any problems or questions in relation to labeling, please ask for assistance at the Registration Desk before 4:30pm on Wednesday.
7. No person is permitted to handle or remove any plant or flower in a display before show close on Sunday without the permission of the Show Marshal.
8. In all matters related to judging the Judges' decision is final. First and Second places will be awarded in all individual classes, except in those in which the Judges consider the exhibit(s) do not reach the necessary standard.
9. Where a sufficient number of quality plants is presented, and an appropriate class is not listed in the Schedule, an extra class may be created by the Judges with the Show Marshal's approval.
10. The Judging Registrar will be an Orchid Societies Council of Victoria Accredited Judge and the show will be judged according to the OSCOV judging rules. Any other accredited Australian or International Judge is welcome to request in advance to be part of the Judging Panel, and the decision of the Judging Registrar on any such matter is final.
11. The Show Marshal or Judging Registrar may remove from the hall any plant suspected of being diseased or otherwise unhealthy.
12. The award of a First prize in a Non-Commercial or Commercial class to a Junior grower will not affect his or her status at the show as a Junior. Where an appropriate class is not available in the Junior Sections, (e.g., Seedling Flowering for the First Time), then a Junior may nominate into a Non-Commercial or Commercial class without prejudice to his or her status at the show as a Junior.
13. OSCOV and the Judges will take care with exhibitors' plants and displays, but none of them accepts any responsibility for any loss, theft, damage or deterioration to any flower, plant or theme materials.
14. By entering plants in the show exhibitors agree to be bound by these Terms of Entry and all discretionary decisions made by the Judges, Show Marshal or Show Co-ordinators.
15. OSCOV reserves the right to photograph any exhibit, exhibitor or display in the show and to reproduce and publish these photographs at any time and in any manner.
16. Society displays may contain plants from Commercial Section growers, provided these plants are appropriately identified as such and that the display has a greater proportion of plants from Non-Commercial exhibitors. Coloured dots to identify Commercial Section growers' plants are available from the Registration Desk.
17. The Show Marshal has sole responsibility to determine the classification of an exhibitor as Commercial or Non-commercial, but he or she may consult with the exhibitor before making that determination.
18. The Show Marshal may finally resolve any dispute, disagreement or other issue arising at any time in relation to the show. All persons affected are bound by any such resolution.
19. The Show Marshal may delegate any power or discretion given to him or her under these Terms of Entry.
20. **Please take note of changes to Nominated classes. This is the exhibitors responsibility**
